The POCKETPAL

The POCKETPAL is an app for your mobile devices that is already populated with information about your Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan benefits and other resources. To help you easily manage your health care — and your family's — The POCKETPAL also allows you to upload information like plan specifics, ID cards and doctor information.

All you need to do to access your benefit information on the web is to visit **mygshombenefits.com**. You will not need to set up a user account or log in.

The POCKETPAL

1. Go to your app store and **search THE POCKETPAL**. You'll recognize it by the red POCKETPAL icon shown below.
2. Download, install and open the app.
3. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and tap **Create an Account**.
4. Enter your Company ID (**courage123**) and tap **Next**.
5. Follow the onscreen instructions to complete the setup.
